Philosophical and Biblical Mission of the Role:
God calls parents to raise their children in the fear of the Lord, teaching them to walk in His ways. Faith Children seeks to aid parents in that call by providing their children opportunities for spiritual growth and engagement with God. The leaders of Faith Children ministry are called to prayerfully and carefully engage with the elementary-age children of the church and community to this end. They seek to share the gospel with children, demonstrate the work of the gospel in their own lives, and support parents in raising Jesus-loving children. They build relationships with both children and parents and seek to encourage both in their pursuit of Christ. This position is part time with flexible hours. Aside from church service, other events, and occasional meetings your time can be managed at your discretion.

Specific requirements:

- Must be a Christian who loves the gospel of Jesus Christ and consistently demonstrates the work of the Holy Spirit in their life
- Must have a passion and inclination toward work with children
- Must pass a background check and submit character references
- Must affirm and agree to teach the Core Tenets of Faith Church
- Must be self motivated and creative
- Must be willing and comfortable to work with and under the guidance of the Director of Children's Ministry, Darren Anderegg
- Should have excellent organization skills and be able to respectfully manage other adults.
- Should have an affinity for effective communication with children for the purposes of teaching and

classroom management

Duties:

Manage the Children's Ministry volunteer team by organizing, communicating, on-the-spot problem solving, encouragement, and training*

Manage and distribute the Sunday morning and Wednesday night curriculum*

Pray for parents and children in the ministry

Plan and execute events for children/families outside of the regular Sunday and Wednesday schedule

Be available on Slack (app/webpage) for communication with church staff

Attend church functions when you can and be a supportive member of the church community (formal church membership not required at this time). Use these opportunities to build relationships with children and families.

Create and teach Bible lessons to children on a regular basis, and coach both parents and volunteer teachers on effective communication strategies

Manage and organize the children's rooms used for Faith Children events*

*Because of the pandemic, some of these duties are not as applicable or have been replaced with alternative forms of engagement. During our virtual church experience, the children's ministry has been creating video lessons and putting on outdoor events. Your assistance with these would be required as long as Faith Children continues to produce them.
