Walk the historic Camino de Santiago from and earn college credit on the way! The Portugese route of the Camino is a 150-mile pilgrimage on foot from Porto, Portugal to Santiago de Compestela, Spain that will take you along beautiful coastlines and hillsides of this history-rich landscape.

Why Walk the Camino with GEO?

- The Camino de Santiago is a shared journey and you will meet pilgrims from all of the world.
- This program has several academic options that allow you to truly Explore while you learn and earn credit! Take one or two classes that satisfy Gen Ed requirements and get you closer to graduation.
- The Camino de Santiago is one of the best travel values in Europe; there may not be a better (or cheaper way) to see and do so much while learning at the same time!
- You will get in great shape preparing for and going on this pilgrimage.



How much will it cost?

The cost of the trip will depend on the academic options you choose. We are offering three academic courses and can earn up to 7 credit hours:

- HON 3113 The Western Experience: Advanced Studies (3 hours toward GenEd Fine Arts, Literature, OR Historical Context requirements)
- **REL 3613** Special Topics in Religion (3 hours toward GenEd Theological Exploration)
- NSC 2204 Natural Science (4 hours toward GenEd Lab Science)

IF you take HON 3113 OR REL 3613 (3 credit hours)	\$3596
IF you take NSC 2204 Only (4 credit hours)	\$4288
IF you take HON 3113 AND REL 3613 (6 credit hours)	\$5252
IF you take HON 3113 OR REL 3613 AND NSC 2204 (7 credit hours)	\$5884

These costs include all tuition, travel, food, activity, and lodging expenses!

This is an international travel experience, so your are responsible for obtaining a passport.

To join the trip **without** taking it for **credit**, the travel fee is **\$2850**. (*Based on space availability*. *Those taking the trip for credit receive priority*.)
